




Summer 2023 Students entering 2nd Grade


Dear Parents,













Poetry books for children are wonderful to read aloud and read together. I would love for each student to find a poem they love this summer and memorize it for our first day of school.




Second Grade is the Roman Year, this book would be a nice introduction to our historical year.
